

Feature: BCRA Origins

Introduction by John Gunn

2023 was the 50th anniversary of the BCRA which was formed in June 1973 from a merger of the BSA (British Speleological Association) and the CRG (Cave Research Group of Great Britain). The late John Wilcock wrote some notes on the formation of the BCRA for the 1994 Cavers' Handbook, published by Ambit. These can be found on the BCRA website [<https://bcra.org.uk/detail/origins.html>] but it was thought they should be reproduced as part of this anniversary edition of the BCRA Review. The wording is exactly as written by John Wilcock, followed by a short footnote written by myself. To the best of my knowledge no-one has attempted to document the history of BCRA over the 30 years since the Wilcock report, and this should be an interesting task for a speleo-historian! Should anyone wish to take on this challenge, then one item that will be of considerable use to them is Trevor Faulkner's documentation of BCRA Scientific Meetings and Field Meetings 1974 – 2018, which was published in the BCRA Annual Review for 2016 (pages 29-35). I also became aware that there is no record of BCRA Officers and post-holders, so I have compiled a separate document that follows this one.

The Formation of BCRA. Notes by John Wilcock

Club caving in Great Britain started around 1900 and at first progressed slowly, with only about 30 clubs in existence by the 1930s. Eli Simpson, or "Cymmie" as he preferred to be called, was a well-known caving organiser in the Settle area of the Yorkshire Dales, before the Second World War. By 1935 he was dreaming of a national caving organisation devoted to speleology. His tremendous enthusiasm for such a venture led him to contact prominent cavers, and the British Speleological Association (BSA) was born, thanks to his drive and energy. The first headquarters was an imposing building in Settle main street, now the Police Station, from where nowadays the first cave rescue callouts are coordinated. In pre-war days the BSA was strongly supported by members referred to by Cymmie as "academics", not without some measure of sneering scorn. However, the BSA organised a successful series of annual conferences, at which a number of prominent people such as the Abbé Breuil and Sir Arthur Keith gave lectures. Conferences were held in Buxton, Bristol, Giggleswick and Swansea, and organised visits to the local caves were well attended. Cymmie's field work included not only exploration in the Craven area, but also cave surveying of a fairly good standard, and the assembly of a mass of photographic and cartographic information. The BSA also supported the formation of local cave exploration chapters in various regions, more akin to modern caving clubs, but affiliated to BSA.

The war resulted in an almost complete suspension of cave exploration, although Cymmie encouraged a number of youngsters, not yet involved in the fighting Services, to keep activities going. By the time peace came, the BSA had changed its character and was little more than a caving club. Cymmie, however, continued as Recorder, handling many enquiries and large volumes of information, mostly from abroad, while encouraging cave exploration by the younger generation. Unfortunately, he alienated a number of the more academic pre-war members, and on their return from the war this resulted in the formation of the Cave Research Group of Great Britain (CRG) by the disaffected members, with the main object of promoting the scientific study of caves. A dominant activity of CRG was its General Meetings, held alternately north and south of the "Glennie Line", an artificial line on the map from Lowestoft to Aberdovey, originated by Aubrey Glennie, which had the effect of treating the Yorkshire Dales, Scottish, North Wales and Peak District caving regions as "North" and South Wales, Mendip and Devon as "South".

The attempt to start a national organisation in 1935 had thus failed because cavers were not ready for such a federal

organisation with individual membership. The explosive growth of caving clubs in the 1950s and 1960s led to the formation of the regional councils of caving, concerned largely with access. By the late 1960s it became obvious that a national organisation was needed, and in 1968 the National Caving Association (NCA) was set up as a federation of the existing autonomous caving organisations representing regions or specialist interests at national level. It was deliberately constituted to include both sporting and scientific interests because these were felt to be inseparable in caving. CRG and BSA actively supported the setting up of NCA and were represented on its Council from the start.

The British Speleological Association and the Cave Research Group of Great Britain formally agreed to merge, and both were wound up on Saturday 23rd June 1973 in Bakewell, Derbyshire. After 38 years of BSA and 25 years of CRG, it was hoped that the existence of only one national body which was fully representative of all the scientific aspects of caves, cavers and their environment would lead to a more positive development of cave science in Britain. The caretaker Council established by mutual agreement of the two extinct bodies was replaced by the first elected Council at the AGM on 15th December 1973 in Skipton. The combined organisation was named the British Cave Research Association (BCRA), an amalgam of the two names. A consequence was that BCRA now had three delegates to NCA Council, a fourth scientific delegate being provided by the William Pengelly Cave Studies Trust. The Peak District chapter of BSA, which had latterly been concerned with the development of technical aids for caving, hived off at this time as the Technical Speleology Group. The first action of BCRA was to formally issue an invitation to the International Union of Speleology for the 7th International Congress of Speleology to be held in Sheffield in 1977. This application was accepted, and a very successful Congress was held which promoted British speleological achievements to the world.

The National Speleological Conferences formerly run by BSA were taken over by BCRA, and the series of very successful conferences continue to the present day. These have been augmented in recent years by regional meetings, after the pattern of the CRG General Meetings. A novel venture in recent years has been the Cavers' Fairs, run in conjunction with NCA and cave rescue organisations. The *BCRA Bulletin* (name later changed to *Caves & Caving*) took over the *BSA Bulletin* and the *CRG Newsletter*. The *Transactions of the British Cave Research Association* (name later changed to *Cave Science*) took over the *Transactions of the Cave Research Group of Great Britain* and *Cave Science* (the Journal of BSA).

Footnote by John Gunn

John Wilcock correctly writes that the *BCRA Bulletin* was replaced by *Caves & Caving*, but in 2003 it was replaced by *Speleology*, the last issue of which (#19) was published in 2016. There is a slight error in that in 1982 the *Transactions of the British Cave Research Association* became *Cave Science (The Transactions of the British Cave Research Association)*. In 1995 there was a further name change and since then the journal has been "*Cave and Karst Science (The Transactions of the British Cave Research Association)*".

BCRA Officers and Post-holders, 1974 - 2023

BCRA is a UK registered charity, and during the 50 years of its existence it has been run by a Council, whose members are also Charity Trustees, and by many volunteers who are not members of Council. The primary officers of BCRA (President, Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer) have always been members of Council but there have been a variety of other posts, some occupied by Council members and some by volunteers. Unfortunately, no record has been kept and as Chair I felt that as part of the anniversary a list of officers and post-holders should be compiled so that the work of many individuals could be properly acknowledged. Compilation of the list took much longer than I originally envisaged and I am grateful to David Gibson, Jenny Potts and Dave Shearsmith for their assistance.

Particularly during the earlier years, it appears that officers commonly changed during the year, but for simplicity the person who was in post for most of the calendar year is listed. The exception is where it is known that there was a change during the year, for example in 2023, when David Gibson and Dave Shearsmith were each in post for six months, and hence both are listed. Once compiled, the list was circulated for comment to all post-holders for whom an email address is available. Some replied saying they were content with the list, some suggested changes and some did not reply. Consequently, the list is regarded as a 'best estimate' that may well have errors and omissions, for which BCRA apologise. Anyone with further information is asked to contact the Chair, and if necessary the list will be updated in the next BCRA Review. For ease of publication the list has been divided into three Tables.

Table 1 lists the posts the holders of which are commonly referred to as the "Honorary Officers": the President, Chairman, Deputy Chairman (a post that is thought to have been discontinued after 1985), Secretary and Treasurer. It has not been possible to find out who (if anyone) was President in 1974, 1980 and 1986 but other than these omissions the list is complete and, hopefully, accurate.

Table 2 lists Membership Secretaries, publication editors, and those who had the responsibility for meetings. Since the inception of the organisation the primary scientific publication has been '*The Transactions of the British Cave Research Association*', initially under that title alone, then as "*Cave Science: The Transactions of the British Cave Research Association*" and, since 1995 as "*Cave and Karst Science: The Transactions of the British Cave Research Association*". From 1974 to 2013 the Association published a journal that was "mainly concerned with news, topical or sporting items". This

began as the *Bulletin of the British Cave Research Association* but in 1978 there was a name change to "*Caves and Caving*" which ran until issue 92 in 2002. In 2003 a new journal, "*Speleology: Bulletin of the British Cave Research Association*" was published and ran to issue 19 in 2013.

In 2015 BCRA Council discussed how we could improve communication with our members and it was agreed that we should instigate an "*Annual Review*" to be published each year prior to the October AGM. The first issue, published in 2016, covered the 2015 calendar year, with subsequent issues continuing to the present. It should be noted that the persons listed as "Meetings Secretary/Manager" in Table 2 are those who have that title in minutes of Council meetings and in various BCRA publications. These persons differ from the Lecture Secretaries listed by Trevor Faulkner in his documentation of BCRA Scientific Meetings and Field Meetings 1974 – 2018 which was published in the *BCRA Annual Review* for 2016 (pages 29-35). The persons listed as "Lecture Secretary on Trevor's list served for the specific meeting listed as opposed to others who had a role within BCRA as a whole.

In addition to scientific meetings, BCRA is thought to have held an annual conference since 1974, but thus far no evidence has come to light as to when, where or who the organiser was between 1974 and 1991. Anyone who can provide this information is asked to contact the BCRA Chairman or Secretary. Fragmentary evidence suggests that between 1985 and 1995 the event was variously known as "The National Caving Conference" (e.g. 1985), the BCRA Conference (e.g. 1987) and the "BCRA National Caving Conference" (e.g. 1991) but in 1996 this changed to "Hidden Earth".

Table 3 lists some of the other posts recorded in minutes of Council meetings or in BCRA publications. Some of these have become redundant over the years (for example, when BCA was formed the post of Insurance Manager moved from BCRA to BCA) and other new posts have emerged (for example, Secretary to the UK Cave Conservation and Emergency Fund (UKCCF)). Not all posts are listed but hopefully the majority have been covered.

On behalf of the present BCRA Council I extend our thanks to all those who have served the Association in the 50 years since its formation, and hope that others will continue to serve with similar dedication over the next half-century.
